DUE DATES FOR INVOICES RECEIVED IN THE MONTH OF April 2018 Determining the correct due date of invoices is one of the most important procedures for you to uphold. Proper due dating means that you compare the date you received the goods or service AND the date you received the invoice. You then choose the later of these two and due date your invoice 30 days from the latest action.
