Please note that in-state and out-of-state students are charged the same rate for meals. Freshmen living in University Housing must subscribe to either the Super Meal Plan, the 275 Block Plan, or the 225 block Plan. All other students living in on campus University Housing may choose any of the meal plans except the 90 Block Plan or the commuter (60 block) plan.

All students living in either the University Apartments or Eagle Landing must subscribe to a meal plan. All meal plans are available to these students except the commuter (60 block) plan.

If you are a residential student, your bill will reflect the meal plan you selected when you completed your residential contract.

Students who wish to change meal plans must do so in your EagleNET portal within the first two weeks of classes. Students should logon on the EagleNET and click on the 'University Life' from the MY UNIVERSITY RESOURCES drop down menu. Once on the 'University Life' page choose the 'Meal Plan Registration' option. Meal plan changes will be effective the following business day.

Please note: Meal plans are carried over from the Fall semester to the Spring semester. You must email umwbills@umw.edu if you do not wish you have your meal plan carried over.
